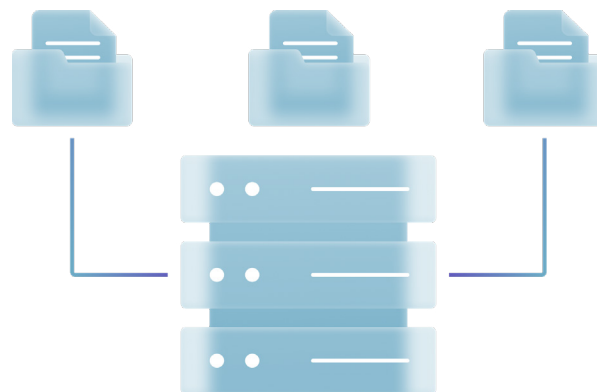

The new Power Historian delivers faster queries and richer data modeling.

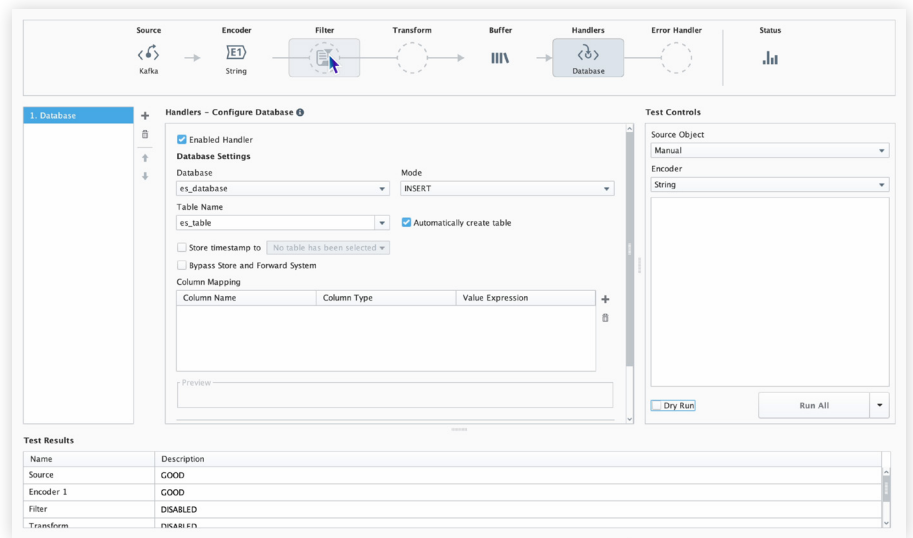


## Create Your Own Historian With the New Time-series API

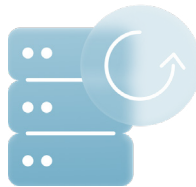
## Handle Event Data With Ease With Event Streams

The Event Streams Module is a new and powerful way to handle event-driven data from a wide variety of sources. Event Streams opens a pipeline of communication between two seemingly disparate things: sources, such as a Kafka topic, and handlers, like scripts. With this module, sources and handlers don't need to know or understand the other in order to work seamlessly together, enabling you to direct your data with ease.



### Centralize Events Management

Handle tag changes, database-related events, alarms, and other events from a central location — and centrally manage that event handling within the Ignition ecosystem.



### Subscribe to More Data

Leverage message queues, brokers, buses, and more to subscribe to data and trigger instant updates and notifications when it changes instead of relying on periodic polling.



### Gain Flexibility for Your Data

Conveniently process data with Apache Kafka to use directly in applications in Ignition, pass it on to external sources, or employ a combination of both using Event Streams.



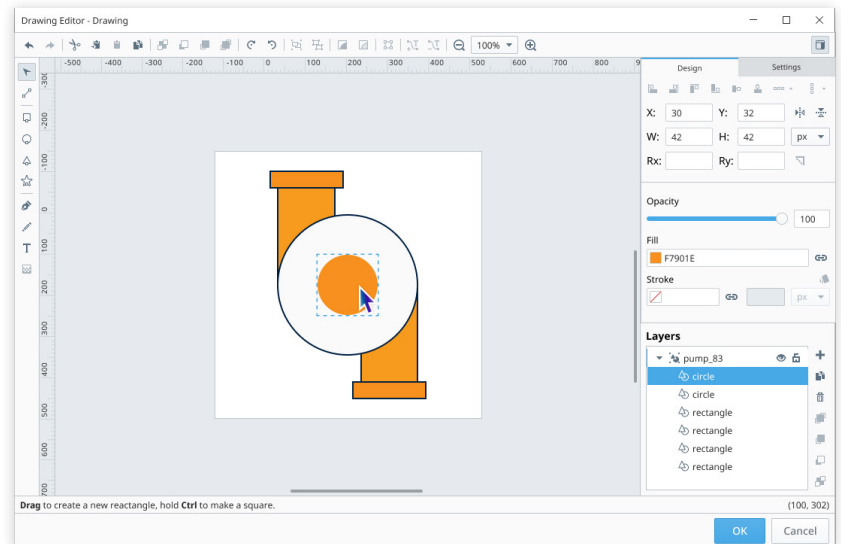
## Keep Your Data Updated With Improved Store & Forward

Bind any graphical element to dynamic sources such as tags directly from Perspective's drawing environment.

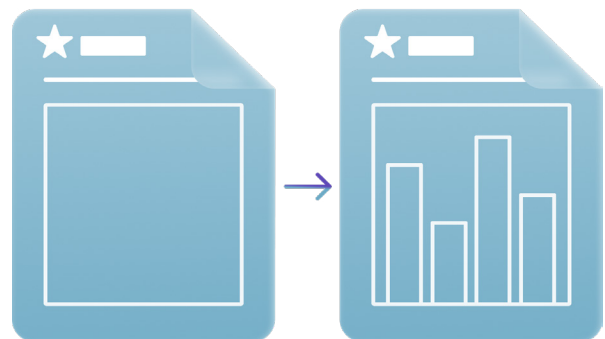


### Add Animations


### One-click Deep-link Launching

### Build, Share & Secure Better With New File System

With Ignition 8.3, everything from gateway configuration and resources to tag definition and storage moves out of the internal database and into file storage for improved visibility and version control in all types of infrastructures and systems.

Ignition 8.3 is compatible with Git, a free and open-source distributed version control system (DVCS) that tracks changes in source code during software development. That means Ignition users have complete version control for a better way to collaborate and organize on big projects.

## Protect Data With Secrets Management

Secrets Management removes passwords, certificates, and encryption keys from Gateway configuration and safely stores and protects your private data. This feature also prevents unauthorized parties from accessing application infrastructure if configuration is shared. On top of that, 8.3 adds extensibility for integration with third-party secrets management platforms such as HashiCorp Vault.



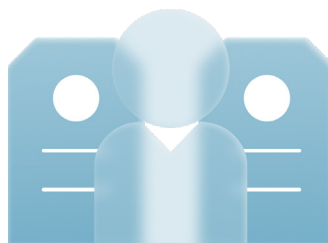
## State-of-the-Art Data Safety & System Security

### Share OPC Data on Your Terms

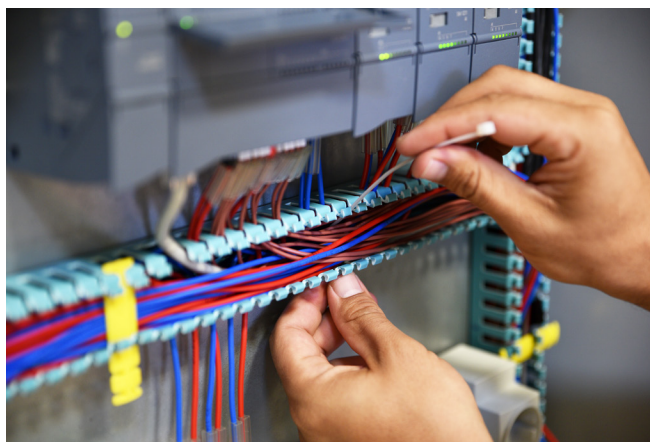

### Control Third-Party Access With OPC UA 1.05

With the latest OPC UA 1.05 specification, Ignition 8.3 provides greater integration and access control for device tags and exposed tags accessed by third-party OPC UA clients. With this, Ignition users can allow third-party access to select or specific devices, tag providers, or folders — and can control the read and write permissions granted with that access.



### Save Time With Siemens S7 Symbolic Driver

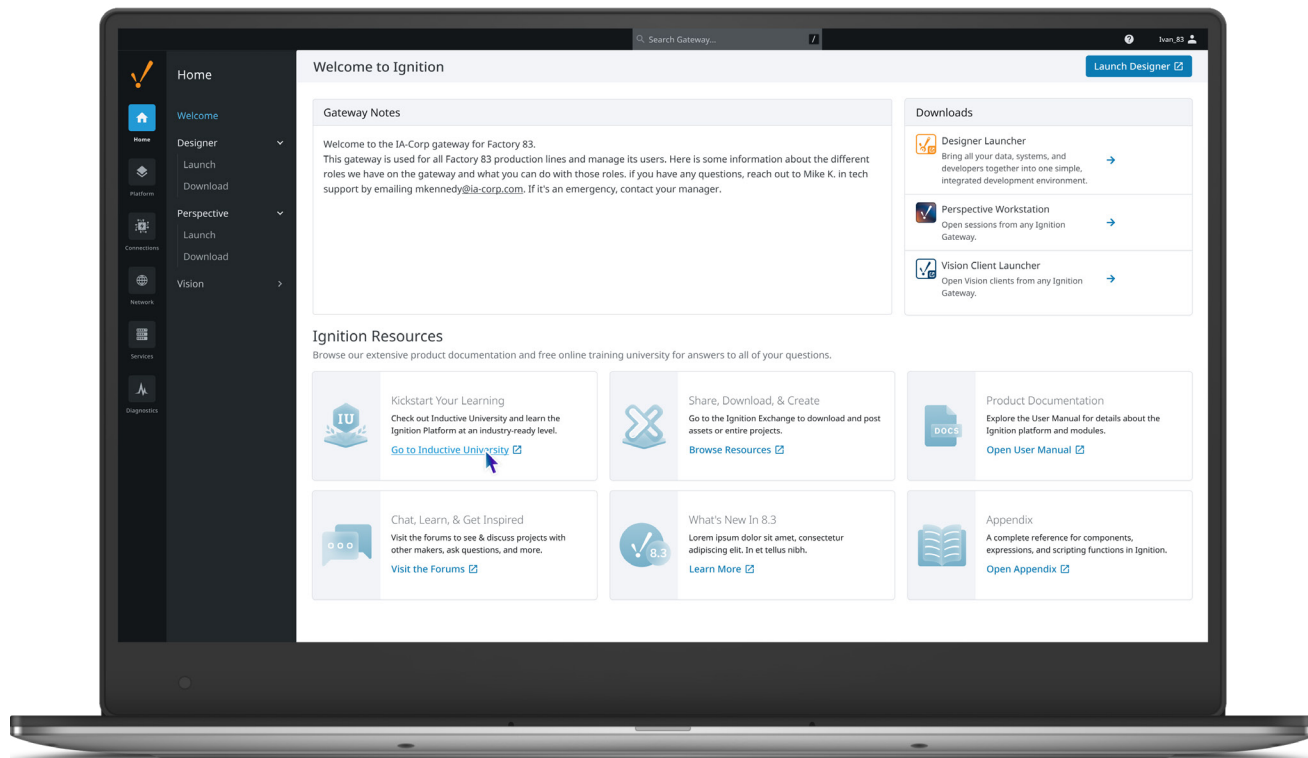
Ignition 8.3 updates the Siemens S7 driver with improved support for using Ignition with Siemens S7 PLCs for browsing, symbolic access, and access to optimized databases. This driver provides direct access to your device's I/O channels using function blocks that do not require manual mapping or reconfiguring of every connected device for each change.

### Alarm Improvements: Get ISA-Compliant Stats, Alarms Over WhatsApp, and More

A new subscription-based Alarm Metrics aggregation model in Ignition 8.3 makes getting ISA 18.2-compliant alarm stats at the UDT or tag folder levels more efficient than ever. Plus, integrations for WhatsApp and Twilio Voice add VoIP messaging and text-to-speech capabilities to your alarm notifications within Ignition.
